Use two varieties from the same or similar flowering times.

Early - Centennial, Chestnut, Hazen, Norland, State Fair, Wealthy, Whitney, Yellow Transparent

Mid - Centennial, Chestnut, Goodland, Honeycrisp, Honeygold, McIntosh, Red Barron, Sweet Sixteen

Late - Haralred, Haralson
